## THEME

Artists are encouraged to present aprons that uplift, create connection and acknowledge the women who care, love and stand for us - Our Sisters.

## HISTORY

Since 2015, over 100 artists from across Australia and overseas have united to create works of art on aprons. The Apron Project has raised over \$60,000 for Women's Shelters by auctioning more than 300 of these aprons online. It has also travelled across NSW to raise funds for local communities and awareness of the growing epidemic of Domestic and Family Violence.

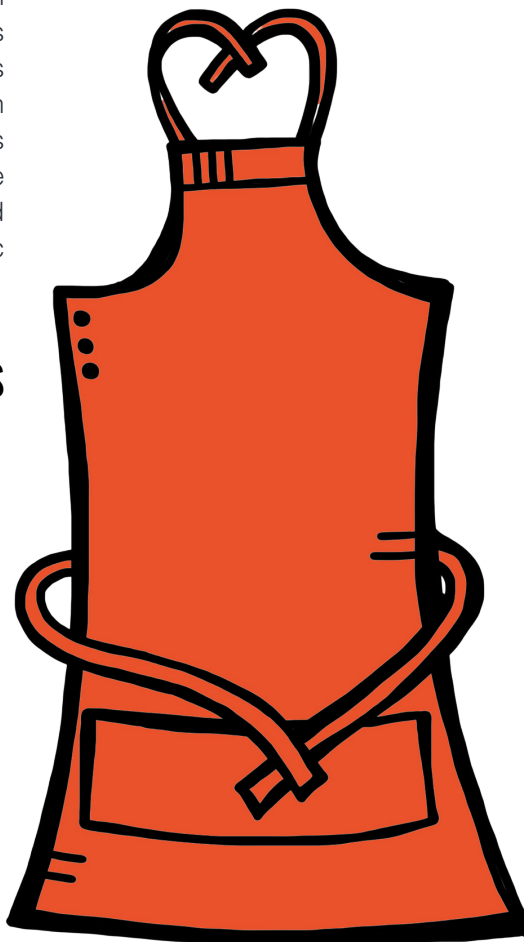
## TANGENTYERE WOMEN'S FAMILY SAFETY GROUP

## AN INVITATION

You are invited to contribute an apron to the Auction. Aprons have an auction starting bid of at least \$100. Many aprons sell for well above \$500

In 2024 we are also calling for Aprons that can be sold for \$25 each. Simple sewn, beautiful fabrics made with loving intention for the wearer.

Auction aprons received prior to July 1 will travel to Alice Springs to be photographed with the Town Camp Women.

All Aprons due by September 1, 2024

Auction and display is scheduled for November 2024 during 16 Days of Activism.
